 Enjoys playing with paper Attends to one toy for 2-3 minutes Plays Peek-a-boo Imitates a gesture (i.e. clapping hands) Finds a toy hidden under a cloth ross Motor Sits without using arms for support Rises up to sitting independently Transitions from sitting to stomach with control Crawls forward on stomach (Commando crawling) Rises up onto hands and knees Pulls to standing Stands while holding onto steady object 	Reaches for toys using only 1 hand Picks up small objects using a raking motion Picks up small objects using an inferior pincer grasp Transfers toys from one hand to the other Bangs toys on the table Language/Communication Responds when name is called Shouts for attention Waves "bye bye" independently Produces consonant-vowel chain "baba"

Becomes excited at reflection in the mirror Experiences "Stranger Anxiety" Explores adult's facial features Lifts arms to be picked up Separates from parent and play on own	 Begins to eat "solids" (i.e. Level 2 baby foods) Feeding self a cracker or baby biscuit Holds bottle independently Sleeps 10-12 hours at night, possibly without waking Naps 2-3x/day
